Everance Webinar: On Tuesday, April 25th at 2pm and 8pm EDT, a webinar entitled: "Insurance: who needs it, and at what age?" will be held. In this webinar, the various types of insurance (health, life, disability, long-term care) will be described as well as which types of insurance is needed, and at what age they are needed. There will also be time for questions.

Delegates at ACA – overwhelmingly affirmed the direction statement proposed by the Ohio Conference Leadership Team. Ninety-three percent of delegates affirmed the direction statement (154 – affirmed, 11 – did not affirm). Given a choice between a "barebones" budget and a "healthy" budget for 2017-18, delegates approved the healthy budget with 98 percent of the vote. The vote total was as follows: healthy budget – 159, barebones budget – 4. Delegates also approved a motion by the Leadership Team to rescind a spending plan resolution adopted at the 2015 ACA. The vote was 97 percent in favor of rescinding that resolution: approved – 160, did not approve – 5.
