## **Prayer of Confession**

Leader: Gracious God,

You reached in to Abraham and Sarah's lives and asked them

to dream the impossible dream--

 $\underline{that\ you\ would\ transform\ what\ appears}}$  to have been a barren and lifeless situation into one overflowing with promise and hope--

and, through faith in you, they believed your promises.

Congregation: Forgive us, O God,

If we never get beyond thinking of your call on our lives as an impossible dream or even as an unwelcome interruption.

Leader: Faithful God,

the apostle Paul emphasizes Abraham's complete trust and faith In your promises and how he grew ever stronger in faith, fully convinced of *your ability to fulfill* what had been promised.

Congregation: Forgive us, O God,

when we find it hard even to hear your promises above commercial assurances of transformation—promises tempting us to trust the newest and trendiest product to realize our dreams.

Leader: Merciful God,

Jesus revealed the great depth of your love in his determination to defeat evil even when this meant giving up his own life.

Congregation: Forgive us, O God,

when we allow the power of evil to flourish because we fear that taking up one's cross would be too costly an exercise.

#### Silent reflection on these words

Leader: Gracious God, we want to hold on to what we know. We are <u>afraid</u>
<u>to take risks</u> for the sake of the gospel; we want to keep our lives
safe. Forgive us, O God, when <u>we cling to comfort</u>, when we build
barriers to protect ourselves, when we choose the easy way.

<u>Transform our fears</u> that we may deny ourselves, take up our cross,
and follow Jesus to serve the world. Amen.
